## INTERMINGLED BLOCK TUTORIAL



Intermingled Cutting Instructions


| $7-2 \times 1.5^{\prime \prime}$ | $14-1.5 \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| $8-2 \times 8.5^{\prime \prime}$ | $15-2 \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $9-1.5 \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ | $16-3 \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $10-1.5 \times 1.5^{\prime \prime}$ | $17-1.5 \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $11-1.5 \times 2$ | $18-1 \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $12-1 \times 5.5^{\prime \prime}$ | $19-2.5 \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ |
| $13-3 \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$ |  |

Once your pieces are cut, you will assemble them into three panels. Panel 1 is then joined along the long side to Panel 2. For Panel 3, join 9, $10 \& 11$. Then join 13, 14, \& 15. Sew all three columns together. Stitch number 16 to the upper panel. Stitch 17, 18, and 19 together and sew to the above sections.

Finally sew the completed panel 3 to panel 2, aligning the seams for the narrow strip (pieces 2, 7, 10 and 14.) Square your block to a finish of 12.5’.
