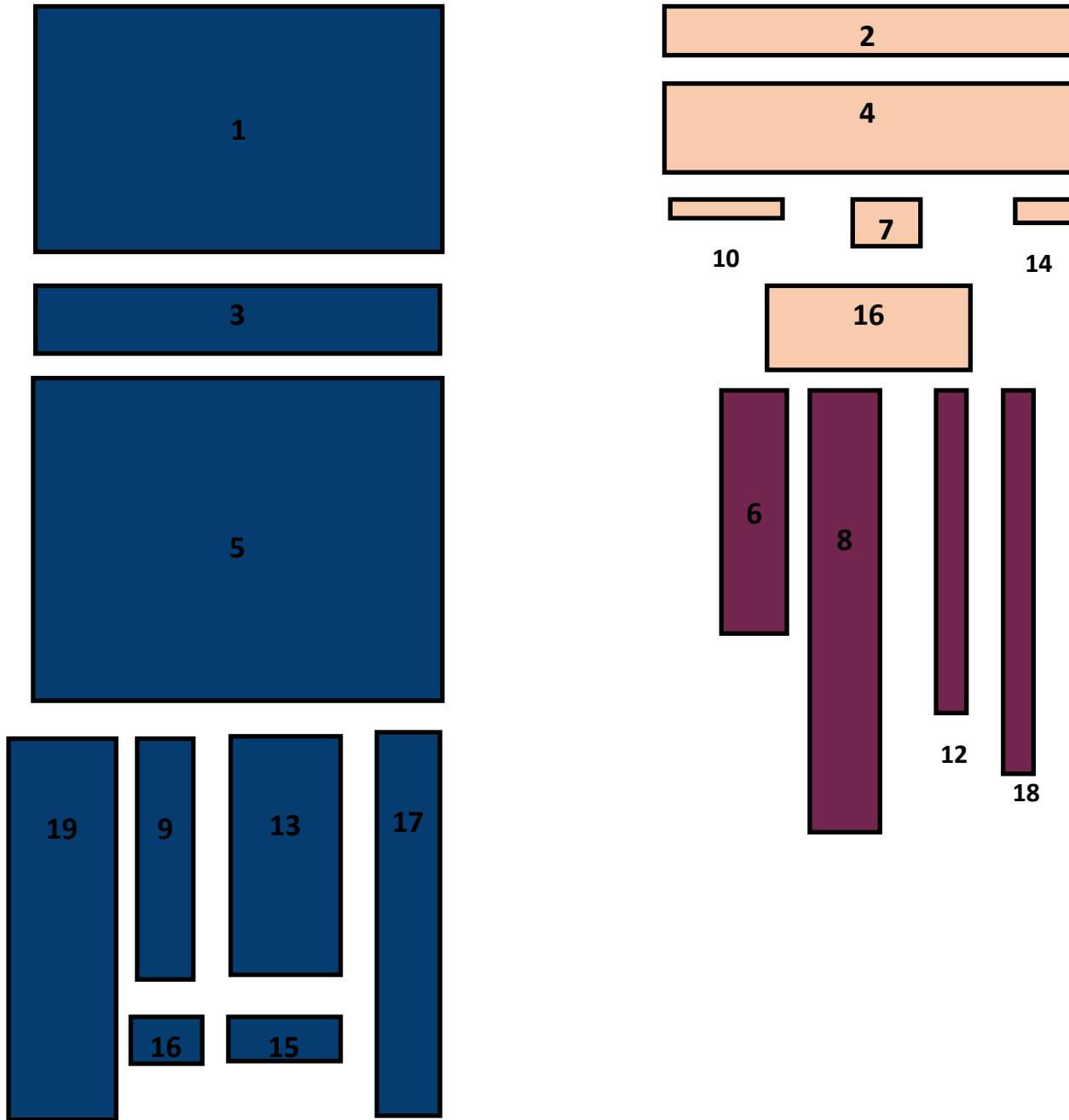


INTERMINGLED

BLOCK TUTORIAL



Intermingled Cutting Instructions



Cut One of Each:

1- 3 x 7.5"

2- 1.5 x 7.5"

3- 2 x 7.5"

4- 3 x 7.5"

5- 5 x 7.5"

6- 2 x 3"

7- 2 x 1.5"

8- 2 x 8.5"

9- 1.5 x 3"

10- 1.5 x 1.5"

11- 1.5 x 2"

12- 1 x 5.5"

13- 3 x 2.5"

14- 1.5 x 2.5"

15- 2 x 2.5"

16- 3 x 4"

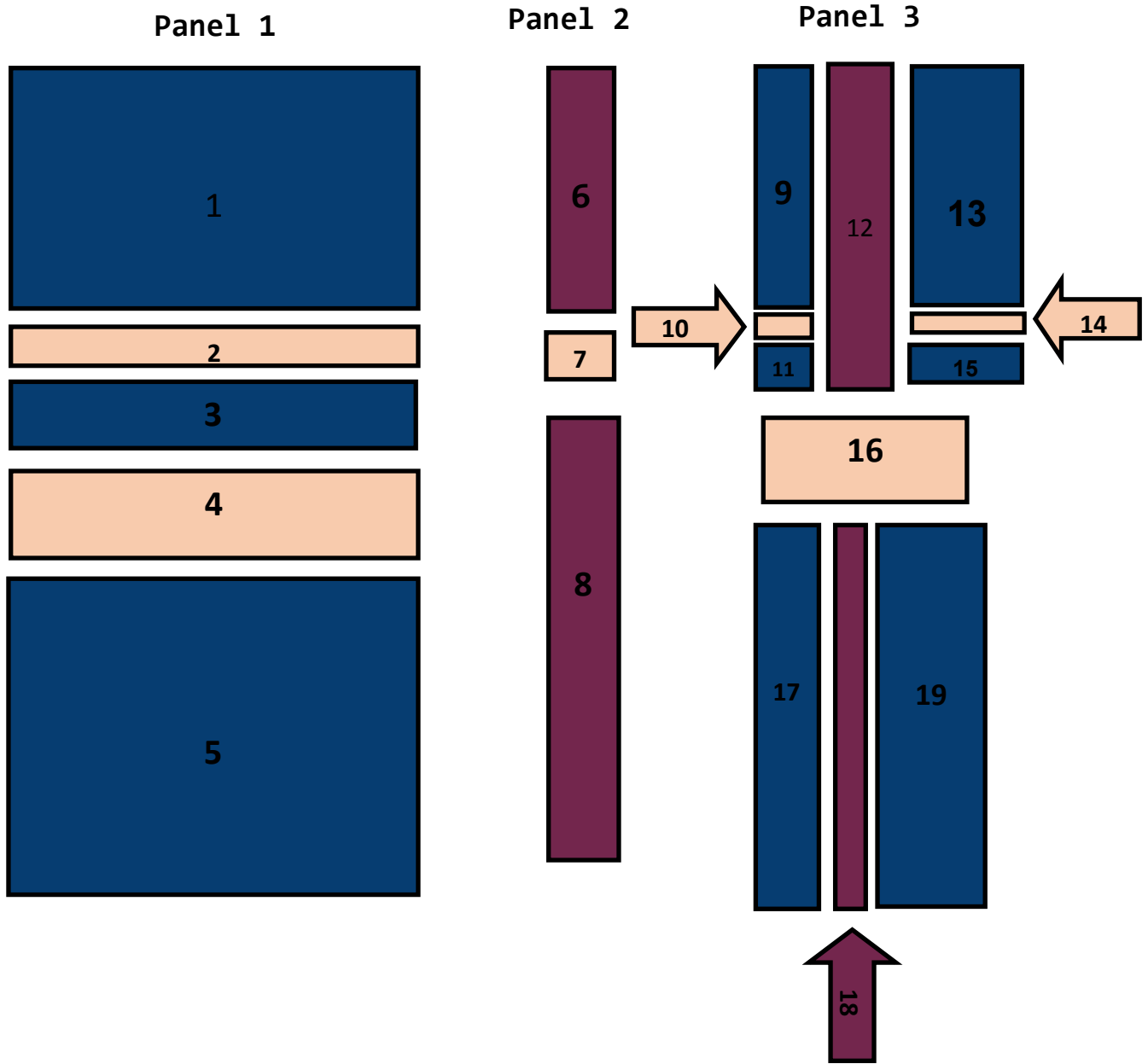
17- 1.5 x 5"

18- 1 x 5"

19- 2.5 x 5"

Once your pieces are cut, you will assemble them into three panels. Panel 1 is then joined along the long side to Panel 2. For Panel 3, join 9, 10 & 11. Then join 13, 14, & 15. Sew all three columns together. Stitch number 16 to the upper panel. Stitch 17, 18, and 19 together and sew to the above sections.

Finally sew the completed panel 3 to panel 2, aligning the seams for the narrow strip (pieces 2, 7, 10 and 14.) Square your block to a finish of 12.5”.



Here is an idea of how these blocks might look placed side by side in a quilt!
